Day	Timing	Activity
Day 1	Afternoon	Depart from London Heathrow
Day 2	Morning	Arrival in Shanghai. Check in at the 4* City View Hotel, on Pudong Avenue. Meet with trip advisors, group leaders and Gabbitas staff from the Shanghai office. Brief introduction of the week's schedule and arrangements. Personal time to unpack and settle in.

	14:00-16:00	Visit to Yu Garden. Students have the opportunity to sample a variety of Chinese dim sum and browse for souvenirs and postcards to send home.
	17:00-18:00	Dinner in Yu Garden.
	19:00-20:00	Head for the most beautiful scene in Shanghai (The Bund). Cruise on Huangpu river to view the historical buildings alongside the Puxi.
Day 3	8:30 – 9:30	Breakfast.
	9:30-11:00	Brief introduction lesson into Chinese history and culture. Shanghai Education TV Station reporters will be present to interview the students about their first impressions and expectations of Shanghai.
	11:30-13:00	Meeting with local Chinese students at their school. UK students together with the local students, learn how to make dumplings, wonton, handmade noodles and other Chinese delicacies.

	17:30-18:30	Dinner in a local restaurant.
	19:30-21:00	Watch Era-Intersection of Time, A Chinese cultural performance combining acrobatics, dance and drama.

Day 7	8:00 – 9:00  Day trip to Xi Tang	<p>Breakfast</p> <p>Departing for Xitang at 9 o'clock in the morning. Xi Tang is an ancient Chinese town 100km from Shanghai. With its quiet natural environment, students will get the opportunity to experience the Chinese countryside, visiting farmers homes where they can pick fresh vegetables, go fishing and take a ride on a traditional Chinese raft.</p> <p>In the evening, students can taste typical Chinese countryside cuisine while taking in the beautiful nighttime scenery.</p> <p>Return to Shanghai around 21:30</p>
Day 8	8:30 – 9:30  10:00-12:30  12:45-13:30 14:00-15:00  15:30-16:30  17:00-19:00  20:30	<p>Breakfast</p> <p>Trip to Shanghai Science &amp; Technology Museum. View the wonders of the 4-D and IMAX dome theaters and experience the 3-D effects of water, wind and smoke. Enjoy a trip to 'science world' and walk alongside pre-historic animals.</p> <p>Lunch</p> <p>Visit Lujiazui CBD, the biggest finance and trade center in Asia which houses the Jinmao Building, Headquarters of HSBC etc.</p> <p>Trip to one of the biggest landmarks of Shanghai—The Orient Pearl TV Tower, the fourth highest tower in the world and enjoy panoramic views of the city.</p> <p>Gala Dinner (Buffet) in the Pearl TV Tower. Students will have the opportunity to have a meal at this stunning venue where they can choose from over 100 culinary delights while enjoying the 360° view of Shanghai city.</p> <p>Back to the hotel for packing and preparing to go home</p>
